

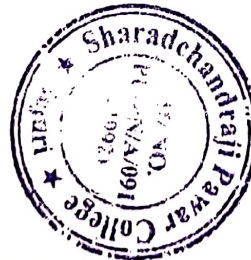

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

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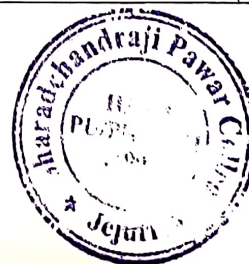

**ALUMNI FEEDBACK ON SYLLABUS**

Considering the changing trends in the mind, in the academic year 2019-2020, Savitribai Phule Pune University initiated the revision and modification of the syllabus of all programs. Therefore, in 2019, Internal Quality Assurance Cell of our college resolved to take feedback on the current syllabus from the alumni. There are seven academic departments (i.e. Marathi, English, Hindi, Political Science, and Commerce) in the college and the IQAC decided to choose 10 alumni from each department. The total 50 feedback forms/ structured questionnaires were distributed among the alumni and the data was collected. The analysis of the data is as follows:

The responses received from the respective respondents are presented in the following table.

It is observed that around 90% alumni believed that the present syllabus satisfied their requirements and gave them a clear idea about the purpose of the course. It is also noted that the syllabus fulfilled its objectives mentioned in the syllabus. Alumni also experienced that the contents of the syllabus had developed a sustained interest in them. It is found that they agreed about the explicit nature of the assessment strategies in the curriculum, and also found that the curriculum was useful at their workplace. They felt that the syllabus was pleasantly challenging, however, it was easy to access through the prescribed/reference books. It is also noted that 84% alumni felt that the curriculum load was optimum without putting any undue pressure on them.

**TEACHERS' FEEDBACK ON THE CURRENT SYLLABUS**

Savitribai Phule Pune University initiated the revision and modification of the syllabus of all programs from the academic year 2019-2020. Therefore, in 2019, Internal Quality Assurance Cell of our college resolved to take feedback on the current syllabus from the teaching faculty of the college. Few teachers from the college had contributed in the syllabus restructuring process. Therefore, the IQAC decided to get first hand feedback from the teachers. There were 17 teachers working in the academic year 2019-2020 in grantable and non-grantable sections. The feedback was taken from all the teachers working in the College. The data was collected and analyzed with the help of a structured questionnaire.

More than 87 per cent of the respondents opined that objectives of the syllabi were appropriate and explained clearly, it accurately described the course, and the work required for the course was sufficient. They also expressed the opinion that the tasks in the curriculum enabled analysis and solving of problems. They also stated that the syllabi offered research possibilities, entailed reference work, included useful textbooks, the time allotted to complete the syllabi was sufficient, and the amount of material for the course was reasonable. Seventy (70) per cent of the respondents agreed that the course offered room for community projects. More than 68 per cent respondents however mentioned that they had not played any role in the designing the syllabi.

**PARENTS' FEEDBACK ON CURRENT CURRICULUM**

Savitribai Phule Pune University initiated the revision and modification of the syllabus of all programs from the academic year 2019-2020. Therefore, in 2019, Internal Quality Assurance Cell of our college resolved to take feedback on the current syllabus from the parents of the students of the college. Feedback responses from 75 parents of the students of the college were collected. The data was collected and analyzed with the help of a structured questionnaire.

The answers replies from the parents of the students of the college are presented as follows:

Around 84% replies of the parent responded positively to the curriculum designed by Savitri Phule Pune University. They also believed that the curriculum developed their ward's academic potentiality and professional skills essential for the jobs of their choice. They also responded positively that the syllabus contained a statement of objectives, they could understand the objectives in terms of their learning outcomes, the contents of the syllabus matched the child's academic interest/aptitude, the curriculum would provide job opportunities to the wards, the syllabus encouraged their wards to go beyond it and consult people/other resources. About 85% of the total respondents felt that there was a need to revise the syllabus. More than 16% of the parents complained about some aspects of the syllabus and also they found that the topics in the syllabus were too limited. The respondents were also asked about how often they had discussed the relevance of the syllabi with teachers to which about 69% parents responded by saying that they had rarely discussed the relevance with teachers whereas 31% never discussed it with their teachers.

The responses received from the respondents are presented in the following Table No 6.



More than 90 per cent of the respondents opined that the present syllabi fulfilled their learning needs, course objectives were clear to them, course contents met with their expectations, contents were illustrated with adequate examples, course exposed them to new knowledge and practices, the course content had contemporary relevance, course seemed useful to them in getting a job, the structure of the syllabus was systematic, and that the topics included were of equal importance.

While answering the question regarding the adequacy of the level of the course, about 70 per cent agreed that it was adequate, whereas 20 per cent felt that it was too low and 10 per cent felt it was too high.
