

She, along with her husband Jyotiba Phule, founded one of the first Indian girl's school in Pune at Bhide wada in 1884. She worked tirelessly for gender equality and against hierarchies based on caste. Savitribai is often referred to as the mother of Indian feminism. Her death, much like her life and work, was marked by selfless service. She died of the bubonic plague while helping victims of the pandemic in Pune.

There were 98 students who were presented for this program. All the faculty members and non-teaching staff were present for this program. The program was introduced by Principal Dr. Dhanaji Nagane. The workshop was moderated by Student Development Cell officer Dr. Rajkumar Rikame.
